

GOPHER BROKE™

Object of the Game:

Be the first to make it around the board 3 times to reach the Millionaire's Mansion

Contents:

7 Custom Dice
Game Board
6 Gopher Tokens
6 Pawns
Instructions



Set Up:

Each player sets their pawn on the Game Board in the gopher hole, and prepares to race around the track. Place all the dice and Gopher Tokens near the board. Take any unused pawns and tokens and set aside.



Game Play:

The youngest player goes first and play continues clockwise after each player takes their turn.

For 2 to 6 Players



10 Minute Playing Time



Ages 6 to Adult



Rolling:

On your turn, roll all 7 dice.

- If you roll more foxes than gophers, your turn ends and you pass dice to the next player.
- If you roll more gophers than foxes, you can move 1 space for each money bag rolled...

OR

- you "Gopher Broke!" and leave your money bags and foxes on the table, and re-roll all gophers to try to get more money bags!
- you may re-roll any gophers until either you move the amount of money bags, or you have more foxes than gophers and you go broke!

IF

- you ever have the exact same number of gophers and foxes you may "bank" any money bags and reroll all dice. "Banked" money bags means that any bags from the first roll are added to any additional rolls, but if you ever have more foxes than gophers, you lose it all - even the "money" you banked!

Moving:

When you decide to move, you move your pawn around the board based on the number of money bags you rolled (see above).

If your movement ENDS on a space occupied by another player, you bump that player back to the gopher hole (0).

After your first trip around the track, you're on your way! You are awarded a Gopher Token. Place the token near you so that the yellow side with 1 money bag is showing. You completed one lap, and your Gopher is now carrying 1 money bag!

Travel all the way around the board again and you may turn over your token to see your Gopher has 2 money bags! You're in the home stretch now!

Note: *You cannot bump another player below 0. If a player is bumped back to 0 on their 2nd or 3rd lap, they go back to 0 on that lap, they do not need to start over on a first lap.*

Winning the game:

If you are the first player to complete a 3rd lap around the board, CONGRATULATIONS, YOU WON! You and your gopher made it to Millionaires' Mansion with plenty of money!
